## SMEA notes from April 27/28, 2001 Board of Directors' meeting, Saskatoon



a motion was passed in January to transfer to the Sask. Arts Board from SaskCulture Inc. for the purposes of securing lottery funding. This in no way affects the amount SMEA receives from the Lotteries. This year our grant was \$133,100.00 and we receive a grant from the STF for \$3000. With all the programs in which we are involved, we generate another \$216,800.00 for a total revenue of \$352,900.00 - quite a sum!



we received notice that the Heart of the City Piano Program received \$9000.00 from the Cultural Advisory Committee. Subsequent applications for the next two years will be made as well. The City of Regina also gave generously to the Program - \$3800.00 was given.

SMC is expanded from 2000 as it will be all day Friday and all day Saturday. Registration information will be coming out in August and you will be able to register online at the music web site ([musiceducationonline.org](http://musiceducationonline.org)).
